# NOTICE OF RACE

## 1 RULES

- 1.1 The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in <u>The Racing Rules of Sailing 2017-2020</u>, subject to alteration by <u>PHRF-BC</u>, the sailing instructions and notification from the race committee.
- 1.2 All boats must comply with 2016 PIYA SER Coastal Category.

# 2 ADVERTISING

**2.1** Boats may be required to display advertising chosen and supplied by the organizing authority.

## 3 ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

- 3.1 The regatta is open to all boats with a valid PHRF-BC certificate and proof of insurance that meet all requirements as stated in the NOR and Sailing Instructions.
- 3.2 Boats without a valid PHRF-BC certificate are welcome to attend and will be assigned a rating by the Fleet Captain.

# 4 REGISTRATION & FEES

- 4.1 TCYC members: \$60.00. Non-members: \$84. Boat may register for single races at the discretion of the Fleet Captain at a rate of \$20 per race.
- **4.2** Competitors must register at <a href="www.tiddlycove.bc.ca">www.tiddlycove.bc.ca</a> prior to racing. Boats that fail to register and pay by 20:00 of the day <a href="prior">prior</a> to racing may not be scored.

#### 5 SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

The sailing instructions will be available by 10:00 on the day of the first race at www.tiddlycove.bc.ca.

## 6 PRIZES

Prizes will be given as follows: Results and nightly awards presented after racing at the clubhouse of the False Creek Yacht Club. Series prizes awarded to the top 3 boats in each division present after the last race of the series July 27. Racers are encouraged to retire to FCYC after each race for results and special prizes. TCYC will endeavour to post results to the TCYC web site each week as soon as practicable.
